


# Demarest Challenge 2018

## “2wt weighing 2oz or less”



This year the Demarest challenge rod is a two weight rod, with a two ounce maximum weight. There is no restriction on length. The rod shaft must be composed of Tonkin Cane, but no other restrictions apply. Ferrules, if any, can be any material, and you must be able to attach a reel to hold the line. Reel seat can be any design or material, as can grip and guides.

Once again, Royal Wulff is supporting this event by making their excellent Triangle Taper 2 weight lines available at a very nominal cost. Entry fee for the event will be \$20.00, which will cover the cost of line, leaders, etc. We are very grateful to Royal Wulff for their continued support, and urge all to remember our friends in the future. Lines will be sent to the entrants in advance, please leave the leader loop intact. If you do not wish to purchase the line, there will be a rigged reel available for loan for purposes of the competition. In that case, entry is free.

Casting will be for accuracy only. A small beetle type fly will be supplied at the time of the event.

There will be a 1' diameter target set at 13 feet, 2' targets set at 16 and 19 feet, and 3' targets set at 22 and 25 feet. If it is at all possible, the casting targets will be set up on the berm side of the pavilion, to help get shelter from the wind. There are trees in the area, so be prepared to cast in a restricted area as part of the challenge. No obstruction bar will be set up this year, due to the difficulties encountered last year with the wind and the light line being used this year. So there will be three rounds of casting, two by the professionals, and one by the rodmaker.
